

How to allow scripting in IE 7 & 8

You are most likely here because you are running Microsoft Internet Explorer as your Internet Browser and it is not allowing you to access a webpage that has scripting or the webpage is coming up as many symbols. Allowing Internet Explorer to temporarily allow scripting will only affect those webpages that do not need a password for you to access. To counteract this problem for a permanent solution see steps below.

1. Go to the tools setting on the very right part of your tool bar.
2. Scroll down to internet options.
3. Click on Security tab at the top of the window
4. Click on the "Internet" icon (should be a globe).
5. Once highlighted, click the custom level button
6. Scroll down to the section labeled "Scripting"
7. Under this section there should be an option for "scripting of java applets" na this should be changed from "Disable" to "Enable"

Going through these steps should allow you access scripted pages. Enjoy
